Capital Letters, Full Stops and Question Marks

Read the following conversation:

The first and the third sentence ask a question. It ends with a question mark (?)
We use question mark (?) to ask question.

The second and the fourth sentence tell the answer. It ends with a full stop (.)
We use full stop (.) at the end of a statement.

Vicky, Shivani and Delhi are special names, which always starts with a capital letter.

All the sentences begin with a capital letter. 'I' is always written in a capital letter in a sentence.

A Put full stop, question mark at the end of sentences and use capital letters wherever necessary.

1. pintu is watering the plants

Pintu...is...watering...the...plants..

2. when did you come

When...did...you...come?



Teacher's Note

Students should be imparted that we use capital letter when we write a sentence. We use full stop at the end of positive and imperative sentences.
