Classes IV to VIII – The theme for the classes IV to XII – “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav – My India - 75 years and beyond”

- i. Poster making competitions
- ii. Slogan Writing
- iii. Essay/Poetry Writing

The following competitions will be conducted between 6th of August to the 12th of August during School hours. **Parents are kindly requested to send one Drawing sheet (minimum size 13x19, maximum chart paper size),**

colour pencils, crayons or water colour with their ward. The posters, slogans, essays and poetry will be displayed on the class notice boards, website and School notice boards. The students may also be given a chance to read out their essays, slogans and recite their original poems during the morning assembly.
